Frisco Family Services assists those who live in Frisco or Frisco ISD (Frisco and parts of McKinney, Plano and Little Elm) who have a documented crisis.

During the 2013-2014 year, Frisco Family Services:

- Served more than **3,900 people**
- Distributed more than **572,000 pounds of food** through Frisco's only food pantry
- Harvested more than **1,000 pounds of fresh, organic produce** through our Community Garden
- Provided more than **\$345,000 in Emergency Financial Assistance**
- Helped our clients maintain or gain self-sufficiency through our **CHAMPS** (CHallenging Adult Minds for Personal Success) **adult life skills workshops**
- Served more than **8,500 lunches** to more than **200 children** through our **Summer Lunch Program**
- Started the school year off right for more than **260 students** with new backpacks, clothes and shoes through our **Back to School Fun Fair**
- Provided more than **240 families** with Thanksgiving meals through our **Thanksgiving Meal Program**
- More than **850 children, parents and seniors** received gifts through our **Holiday Store Program**
- Awarded **4 scholarships** to Frisco ISD students
