Food Pantry

Frisco's only community Food Pantry is client choice, where clients can shop in a grocery store-like setting for the food they know their families will eat. As a result of COVID-19, clients enjoyed safe access to the food pantry and shopped while social distancing. We utilized our mobile food pantry, which delivered groceries and other food pantry items to our seniors and home-bound clients, to reduce the risk of exposure for those sheltering at home.





Self-Sufficiency

Emergency Financial Assistance helps families stay in their homes, keeps utilities connected and provides for other critical needs. Adult Life Skills classes provide tools to help clients get back on their feet. Since the pandemic began, we followed safety guidelines by moving our face-to-face classes online.

Summer Lunch Program

The program provides free lunches and weekend meal bags to local children during the summer. This year, we added "Fresh Fridays" where boxes of fresh produce were distributed. Due to COVID-19, we adapted the program to follow safety recommendations, where parents and children "drove-through" to pick up their meals during the nine-week program.







Thanksgiving Meal Program

We provided individuals and families with a turkey and groceries to make their Thanksgiving meal at home, as well as breakfast items and a DVD or a family game.
