## FEEDFRISCO Community-wide Food Drive

As a convenience, there will be a pullup **donation drop-off lane in front of the Frisco Family Services Market, 9085 Dogwood St**., Frisco, where staff and volunteers can assist with unloading.

### FRISCO RESALE Clothing Drive

Similarly, Frisco Resale, 9125 Dogwood St., Frisco, will host a clothing drive from 10 a.m. to **3 p.m.** As a convenience, a Frisco Resale truck will be parked in front of the store to receive new and like-new clothing. All Frisco Resale proceeds go toward Frisco Family Services' programming and services.

"The need for a combined drive for the most basic essentials reflect how hard record inflation is impacting Frisco families and seniors," said Frisco Family Services Executive Director Nicole S. Bursey. "Together, we can help our neighbors experiencing a crisis maintain or regain self-sufficiency."
